Academic Financial Assistance Program Application

Eligibility:

Applicants must be descendants (or a descendant of a legally adopted child) of an Association member.

Applicants must be within one of the following categories:

1. Currently enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college or university and is maintaining a GPA of at least 3.0.
2. Be a high school graduate or high school senior with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
3. Have successfully completed a general education development program of study and have been awarded a diploma by a recognized state or local education agency.
4. Be attending, or preparing to attend, a vocational or technical training institution, pursuing a course of study that requires a minimum of 25 credit hours.

Deadline:

Applications must be received by the Financial Assistance Chairman (FAC) not later than June 30 each year. Awards will be announced not later than August 1 each year and financial assistance funds will be sent directly to the education institution to be applied for the fall semester.

4. A copy of your letter of acceptance from the education or training institution.
5. Evidence you are a descendant of an Association member (or of a legally adopted child of same) (**personal letter from the member to the FAC will suffice**).
6. Address of college/institution with phone number and name of contact where funds should be sent. Also, include your student ID Number.
